Seven Sisters Small Quilt Challenge – June 29-30, 2019

“A Touch of Red”

Choose a pieced, appliqué, pictorial or abstract design.

Rules:

- **Quilt perimeter can be a maximum of 80”.** The quilt can be any shape as long as the perimeter is 80” or less. One challenge quilt entry is allowed per person.
- **Showcase the color Red.** In the artist statement explain your vision for the use of the challenge theme.
- **The quilt must have a sleeve that is at least 2 1/2” wide.** If your quilt is a non-rectangular shape (i.e. circular), you may attach it to a white backing with a 2 ½” sleeve that will allow your quilt to hang properly.
- **The Title & Artist Statement is due** to your guild representative by **April 19th**. *The artist statement should be no more than 30 words. Longer artist statements are difficult to read when displayed with the quilt.*
- Your Challenge quilt must be turned into your guild challenge rep. by **June 12th**.
 - Quilt must be in a **pillowcase**, label with your name and guild, **no picture** is needed.
 - If possible, your quilt should **not** be folded in the pillowcase.
 - If the quilt has a label, cover the quilter’s name with a scrap fabric.

**Quilts will be judged for Viewer’s Choice - Three ribbons will be awarded.
There will also be a sponsored award**
