


## Seven Sisters Quilt Show – FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



- Q: Where can I find (**SPECIFIC VENDOR**) booth?  
 Show them in the program how to find if the vendor is here, the number of the booth, and where that is located using the map in the program.
- Q: Where would I find \_\_\_\_\_ Guild's **OPPORTUNITY QUILT**?  
 Refer them to the Information Table where there is a map showing opportunity quilt locations.
- Q: I am looking for a specific quilter's **QUILT**. How do I find it?  
 Show them in the program how to find the quilter alphabetically and how to find the bay with his/her quilt from the map. Point out that each bay is numbered with a white flag.

## EXIT INFORMATION

- Q. How do I get out?  
You may leave through the 3 sets of double doors at the front of the building: 2 on the sides and 1 leading to the front parking lot.
- Q. How do I get the van to my car?  
There is a pick-up area outside near where you came in at the front of the tent.

## TIME/LOCATION OF DRAWINGS

- Q. When and where is the announcement for Viewers' Choice and the drawing for the Information Table Raffle?  
Sunday afternoon at 3 p.m. in the entry to the lobby.
- Q. When and where is the drawing for the Raffle Baskets, fabric cakes, etc.?  
Saturday at 4 p.m. and Sunday at 3 p.m. in the entry to the lobby.
- Q. When are the Challenge Quilt and Wearable Art ribbons awarded?  
Sunday afternoon at 3:15 p.m. in the entry to the lobby.
- Q. When are the drawings for opportunity quilts?  
This is different date for each quilt as set by the individual Guild. Visit each booth to learn about their individual drawing dates.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Q. Why doesn't this great quilt have a ribbon?  
Not all quilters choose to have their quilt judged; it may not have been the best in its division (such as small pieced quilt); sometimes a quilt looks great, but the judge finds technical problems with the way it was made.
- Q. Do you have quilts for sale?  
Yes. There is a vendor booth in the main building. In addition, some quilters are willing to sell the quilts on display. If they are, it will say so on the card attached to the quilt.
- Q. What is an opportunity quilt?  
An opportunity quilt is a quilt being raffled by a guild to support their educational and charity efforts. Usually opportunity quilts are made by several members of the guild working together rather than by one individual.
- Q. How can I become a vendor at this show?  
You may contact anyone from the vendor committee to assist you (they are wearing red aprons) or check our web site [sevensistersquiltshow.org](http://sevensistersquiltshow.org).
- Q. When can I pick up my quilt, challenge, and/or wearable art and take it home?  
Individual quilters may not enter the main building to obtain their individual entries. All Acquisitions committee members who are there to take the quilts back to their individual guilds must stay within the main building until every single quilt has been returned to its proper guild and all guilds agree they have all their quilts. At that point, one of the Quilt Show Co-Chairs will announce that Acquisitions may leave the building with quilts. Individuals may only get their quilts from the Acquisition committee members outside the building after they have been cleared to leave. Wearable Art and Challenge entries are basically the same, but are handled by their respective committees. Quilters must wait outside to obtain their entries.
