



STANDING RULES

Section 1. Meetings. Unless otherwise ordered by the membership or the Executive Board, the meetings of the AQGCC shall be held monthly from January through December, and at a time and place established by the Board of Directors.

Section 2. Membership. Annual dues for Member Guilds shall be established annually by the Executive Board.

Section 3. Memorandums of Understanding (MOU). MOUs define the relationship between AQGCC and the Member Guilds. MOUs are disseminated to the Member Guilds in October to be signed by the Guild President and returned by December 31 of the same year. The MOU for membership is in effect from January 1 – December 31. The MOU for the show is from January 1 of a given year to August 31 of the following year (20 months).

Section 4. Grants Advisory Committee. A Grants Advisory Committee shall be established to seek out and maintain grant funding in support of the purpose and objectives of the AQGCC.

Section 5. Member Guild Brochure. A brochure describing the activities, meeting days and contact information for each Member Guild shall be published by the AQGCC for distribution to the regional quilt and fabric shops.

Section 6. Website. The AQGCC shall maintain a website.

Section 7. Equipment. Elected Officers, Member Guild Representatives and Standing Committee Chairs shall maintain Procedure Manuals (binders). The Procedure Manual will include Bylaws and Standing Rules and a current position description. AQGCC maintains a storage unit and equipment used for the Seven Sisters Quilt Show and other events.

These Standing Rules may be changed or amended by a majority vote of the Board of the Associated Quilt Guilds of the Central Coast.
